Bells	<p>The cathedral is unique in North America in having both a carillon and a set of change ringing bells.</p> <p>The ring of 10 bells (tenor 32 long cwt 0 qr 4 lb; 3,588 lb or 1,627 kg in D) are hung in the English style for full circle ringing. All ten were cast in 1962 by Mears & Stainbank (now known as The Whitechapel Bell Foundry) of London, England.</p> <p>The carillon has 53 bells ranging from 17 pounds (7.7 kg) to 24,000 pounds (11,000 kg) and was manufactured by John Taylor & Co of Loughborough, England in 1963.</p> <p>The bells are hung dead, meaning rigidly fixed, and are struck on the inside by hammers activated from the keyboard.
